

Need Transportation?



A bicycle is healthy, dependable, and affordable transportation.

Adults living in Lehigh County who qualify* can build their own bicycle and receive training and support at no cost.

What you'll receive:

- A bike that you build yourself with CAT's expert mechanics' help
- Helmet, head & taillights, and lock
- Training on traffic skills and maintenance
- Help planning your bike routes
- Learn how to use bike racks on LANta Buses
- Bicycle commuter support for 12 months

This program is made possible through a Community Development Block Grant with the County of Lehigh.

*Requirements for Adult Bicycle Commuter Program

- Open to residents of Lehigh County who live outside of Allentown or Bethlehem cities (age 16 to adult)
- Household annual income below \$43,800 for one-person, \$50,050 for two-person (contact CAT for other household sizes)
- Candidates must volunteer a minimum of 5 hours with CAT before receiving their bikes
- Candidates must be able to get to CAT via LANta Bus or other means for approximately five visits (CAT is on LANta's 107 and 220 routes)
