

Build a Bike for Transportation

Adults can build a bicycle for free at the CAT Bicycle Cooperative by volunteering 5 hours to help repair bicycles for others.



After clients volunteer, they choose their own bicycle from those that are available to refurbish. This bike-build generally takes 4-5 hours for a total client investment of about 10 hours.

This program is FREE to clients.

Included with your bicycle:

- Bike lock
- Bike lights (head & taillight)
- Helmet
- Bike2Work Basics Training
 - 1 hour classroom
 - 1 hour on-bike
